Trees and shrubs are sold with the understanding that they will not be removed from the planted site for resale with the roots attached. Orders are filled on a first-come, first-serve basis. The District reserves the right to refund payment on items if they should become unavailable. Because the District cannot ensure proper planting location, guard against improper planting or handling, guarantee sizes (due to the growing season and/or weather related problems); the District will not be responsible for replacement or refunds of orders after distribution. 


SEEDLING PLANTING TIPS

Your seedlings are packaged with root gel and mulch. Root gel will hold moisture in the root zone during storage, planting and the first few months in the ground. There are a number of important things to keep in mind to ensure maximum survival of your seedlings.


1. Seedlings should be planted as soon as possible, preferably within two days of pick-up.
2. Keep your seedlings moist and stored in a cool dark area until planting. **If you choose to soak your seedlings, we recommend soaking for no more than 30 minutes.** If there will be a delay of more than a few days, seedlings should be planted in a shallow trench and covered with moist soil.
3. Transport and handle seedlings carefully, avoiding root damage.



4. Plant seedlings so the crown is level with the surface of the ground, making sure that all roots are in the hole and covered. Place the roots straight down the hole in a natural arrangement. Do not bunch, spiral, double-over or bend roots.



5. Using your toe, press down on the soil around the seedling to remove air pockets.



6. Mulch or use landscaping fabric to conserve moisture, reduce competition from weeds, and minimize extreme temperatures in the root zone.
7. Consider tree shelters for hardwood trees. Shelters help reduce moisture stress, locate the seedlings, and protect from mice, rabbits and deer.
8. Water seedlings regularly or as needed. Reduce competition from surrounding grass or weeds by mowing or trimming.
