**MISCELLANEOUS**153 Dean RoadFill Permit

Jack Barton passed out a letter (dated 6/28/2007) from Tony D'Arpino, the developer representing the owners of the property, requesting a fill permit to be issued per the approved plans. Mr. Barton then showed the approved plans to the Board. The plans were approved on 10/28/1986.

Acting Chairman Tod Ferguson stated that if they are "stockpiling" the topsoil that is stripped from area that is being filled they will need to place a silt fence around the "stockpiled" area and seed the topsoil mound as soon as possible.

A discussion was held on the fact that the approval of this plan needed to be updated.

**A motion was made by Tim Harner and seconded by Rick Holden to updated the approval of these plans for another two years and to grant a 90 day fill permit in accordance to the approved plans and with the condition that the topsoil be "stockpiled" and silt fencing be placed around the area and the pile be seeded as soon as possible. Motion carried unanimously 3-0 (Ed Fuierer and Bob Pelkey absent).**

Ogden Parma Town Line Road SubdivisionLot #13Approval Update

Jack Barton presented to the Board the originally approved plans for Lot #13 of the Ogden Parma Town Line Road Subdivision and stated that the owners of the property would like the Board to updated their approval for another two years.

After reviewing the plans and discussing the plans, **a motion was made by Rick Holden and seconded by Tim Harner to updated the final approval of Lot #13 of the Ogden Parma Town Line Road Subdivision for another two years. Motion carried unanimously 3-0 (Ed Fuierer and Bob Pelkey absent).**

There being no further business **a motion was made by Tim Harner and seconded by Rick Holden to end the meeting at 7:51 p.m. Motion carried unanimously 3-0 (Ed Fuierer and Bob Pelkey absent).**
