

Deer Management Permits Available

**The Parma Town Clerk's office will be open
Saturday, November 1, 2014
from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon.**

for the sale of First Come/First Serve DMP's and continue on Monday during regular business hours (8:00 - 4:00) for DMP's which are still available.

The NYS Department of Environmental Conservation has announced that starting Saturday, November 1, 2014 Deer Management Permits (DMP) will be issued on a first come/first serve basis for hunters with current NYS Hunting License. If you have already purchased your DMP for 2014 you are eligible to apply for two additional permits in areas where they are still available, at no additional charge. If you have not purchased a DMP for the 2014/15 season, there will be a \$10.00 charge. Per the DEC the following areas will have permits available:

1C: including all of Suffolk County.

3M, 3R, 3S (bow hunting-only): including parts of Orange, Sullivan, Ulster, Rockland, and Westchester Counties.

7F, 7H, 7J: including parts of Cayuga, Onondaga, Cortland, Tompkins, Madison

8A, 8F, 8G, 8H, 8J, 8N, 8R: including parts of Monroe, Niagara, Orleans, Erie, Genesee, Livingston, Ontario Wyoming, Steuben, and Yates Counties.

9A, 9F, 9G: including parts of Erie and Niagara Counties
