**Corning Museum of Glass & Rockwell Museum**  
**Corning, NY**

Upon arrival at the Corning Museum of Glass we will meet our tour guide for a walking tour to rediscover the wonder of glass in the expanded space of the museum. This tour will be about an hour and will end with the hot glass demonstration. Lunch will be on your own in the Café with your \$15 gift card and any money left over you can use in the gift shop. There will be some free time to explore on your own if you wish. We will depart at 1:45 pm for The Rockwell Museum where you will receive a guided tour and see an incredible collection of art and experience the people, land and ideas that shaped America, often described as "Best of the West in the East." If you have not been to Corning in the past 2 years don't miss this tour. This trip will require leisurely walking of at least an hour at various stops. **Local TV Station(tentative), Artisan Works tour, Genesee Brewery Tour & Lunch and Rochester Museum and Science Center Planetarium**

**Mark Twain Country  
Elmira, NY**

With an early departure, we will make a coffee stop on the way to our adventure today. Upon arrival in Elmira the group will split into two; some will do Trolley Tour around town, while the other half will enjoy the Mark Twain Boyhood Home and Museum. We then switch the group so everyone gets the same experience. Inside the museum we will enjoy the exhibits, documents and a collection of the evidence of Mark Twain. On the trolley you will hear about the history of the town where Mark Twain lived and wrote, see Civil War sites, pass by the Victorian homes on Maple Ave. and come face to face with the intriguing past of Elmira. Your lunch will be at the Hill Top Restaurant with breath taking views. After lunch enjoy some Christmas in July shopping at The Christmas Shoppe. The final visit of the day will be a tour of the Soaring Museum which houses the largest collection of sailplanes in the world and also a piece of the wing cloth from the Wright brothers' first flight at Kitty Hawk. Dinner will be on your own at Tom Wahl's in Avon. Activity level of this trip is a 2 as some walking will be required during the tours.

**Arcade & Attica Railroad & Historic Museum  
Batavia, Attica, Arcade, NY**

This tour will start out with a stop at the Holland Land Office Museum in Batavia, “Welcome to the Birthplace of Western NY”. Enjoy the gallery that displays artifacts representing 200 years of history collected from around Genesee County and Western New York. Learn the difference between a gibbet and gallows. The museum's gibbet was built in 1859 and three condemned people were hung on this particular gibbet. Then it is off to East Aurora for lunch at the Medici House, family owned and operated. In the afternoon it's ALL ABOARD the Arcade and Attica Steam Train. Enjoy a 2½ hour “Train to Yesterday” ride through the countryside viewing the local fall foliage aboard the last operating steam train excursion in New York State. Activity level of this tour would be a 1-2 some walking at museum required.

### **Registration Procedure and Information:**

1. Pick-up and departure from Hilton Senior Center, 59 Henry Street, Hilton, NY
2. **Since the Town of Parma heavily subsidizes these trips, they are open to Town of Parma** residents age 55 and up at a subsidized fee. Those who do not live in the Town of Parma will be accommodated if space is available; however they will be required to pay the full price of the trip.
  - a. **If you pay Hilton School Taxes but do not pay Town of Parma taxes, the non-resident rate will apply.**
3. The following is the procedure for trip registration: Complete registration form or register online at [www.parmany.org/Recreation](http://www.parmany.org/Recreation) at any time after the stated registration open date. Completed forms should be turned into the Recreation Office. In the case of seating requests, submit information on the registration form with any other requirements such as food choice and emergency contact. Places cannot be held for people and we will take a waiting list if a bus fills. If cancellations occur, placements will be taken in order from the waiting list.
4. We recommend that interested participants register for any trip 2-3 weeks prior to the trip date at the latest as many of the trips have 2-3 week requests for final attendance counts.
5. **REMINDER:** The first two sets of seats are reserved for those who have a difficult time maneuvering up and down the aisle. **NOTE:** Front seat requests will be taken at registration but please be aware that these seats are limited.
6. Please be at the pick-up point at least 10 minutes prior to the designated departure time. **Passengers should NOT plan to board the bus early to save seats.**
7. At each stop, we will alternate which side of the bus exits first. However, people with special needs will exit first.
8. We are required to have a minimum number of people (30-35) on the bus. If our minimum is not reached, other options will be explored, including a possible cancellation of the trip.
9. For your safety, we ask that you remain seated until the bus comes to a complete stop.
10. Payment by check, cash, money order, MasterCard, Discover or Visa is accepted. Make checks payable to: **Town of Parma.**

### **Cancellations & Refund Policy:**

1. Cancellations received in the Recreation Department (392-9030) prior to the trip confirmation deadline will be refunded with a processing fee of 10%. Cancellations received after the confirmation date or "no shows" will **NOT** receive a refund unless someone else is found to take the place of the cancelled party. **We will attempt to give refunds whenever possible, but please realize that refunds are NOT guaranteed.** If a refund is approved you also have the option to put a full credit for the amount paid on your account to be used at a later date.
2. All replacements will be handled by the Recreation Department from the waiting list if one exists. You may give your spot to a friend if there is no waiting list established.
