### **Luck of the Irish “Penny Whiskey” Irish Luncheon Show Batavia, NY**

Today is your lucky day, at Batavia Downs. Upon arrival you will receive **\$15 in Free Play** to test your luck at over 500 slot machines. Grandstand Ballroom doors open at 11:15 a.m. – your table is pre-assigned so no need to rush. For lunch we will enjoy an Irish/American buffet. Following lunch at 1 p.m., “Penny Whiskey” takes the stage. This is a group of fun loving folks who truly have a good time doing what they love most... entertaining. “Penny Whiskey” promises to offer the best in music from both Ireland & Scotland along with home grown bluegrass, complete with kilts. With audience participation songs, rousing pub songs, comedy tunes and tearful ballads, “Penny Whiskey” offers something for everyone! The group will depart at 3:30 p.m. for a short drive around the corner to Oliver’s Candies, where you will have a short 10 minute walking tour of the production area, receive a chocolate treat and have some shopping time.

### **Niagara Falls Aquarium, Culinary Center & Niagara Power Vista Center Niagara Falls, NY**

Enjoy a morning visit and Penguin Show at the Niagara Falls Aquarium. Next stop, the Niagara Falls Culinary Center where you will have a 45 minute guided walking tour experiencing the state-of-the-art culinary and pastry kitchens. Begin your tour at the two-story water wall where you will see how a \$25-million dollar renovation turned the Rainbow Mall into the world class Niagara Falls Culinary Institute. You will journey across 3 floors entering our unique ice lab and a professional kitchen, where treats may be offered along the way. After the tour a lunch buffet will be served – all prepared onsite. A short time will be allowed to shop at La Patisserie; the onsite bakery. Then it is off to visit the Niagara Power Vista Center. Your visit begins at reception, where you will receive a Power Player RFID card for your journey through the Power Vista. Tour guides will be on hand and happy to help you activate your Power player card. Be sure to keep it handy - it is your "passport" to unlocking the full experience and accessing your saved media from the visit! This stop will be an inspiring packed adventure with electrifying moments and scientific exploration. With the latest hands-on interactive technologies, multi-sensory 4D theatre, large touch screens, STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, Math) exhibits, redesigned floor layouts and new elevator to enhance accessibility. We end the day with a shopping stop at Gordie Harper's Bazaar in Newfane, a co-op flea market with a restaurant.

**Medina Railroad & Museum with Lockport City Tour**  
**Lockport, NY**

This tour will start out with a step on guide in Lockport NY – for the history of a canal town. Followed by lunch on the canal at the Basket Factory, which was once the site of the "Royalton Basket Co." in 1893. All sizes of

baskets, from bushels to peach, berry baskets and crates, were made here, providing the local farmers fast and easy ways to ship their goods on the canal. Then it's ALL ABOARD to enjoy a 1 ½ hr. fall train ride on the Medina Railroad with time to stroll through the Medina Railroad Museum. Finish the day with a stop at Watt Farms.

### **Registration Procedure and Information:**

1. Pick-up and departure from Hilton Senior Center, 59 Henry Street, Hilton, NY
2. ***Since the Town of Parma heavily subsidizes these trips, they are open to Town of Parma*** residents age 55 and up at a subsidized fee. Those who do not live in the Town of Parma will be accommodated if space is available; however they will be required to pay the full price of the trip.
  - a. **If you pay Hilton School Taxes but do not pay Town of Parma taxes, the non-resident rate will apply.**
3. The following is the procedure for trip registration: Complete registration form or register online at [www.parmany.org/Recreation](http://www.parmany.org/Recreation) at any time after a trip is advertised. Completed forms should be turned into the Recreation Office. In the case of seating requests, submit information on the registration form with any other requirements such as food choice and emergency contact. Places cannot be held for people and we will take a waiting list if a bus fills. If cancellations occur, placements will be taken in order from the waiting list.
4. We recommend that interested participants register for any trip 3-4 weeks prior to the trip date at the latest as many of the trips have 3-4 week requests for final attendance counts.
5. **REMINDER:** The first two sets of seats are reserved for those who have a difficult time maneuvering up and down the aisle. **NOTE:** Front seat requests will be taken at registration but please be aware that these seats are limited.
6. Please be at the pick-up point at least 10 minutes prior to the designated departure time. **Passengers should NOT plan to board the bus early to save seats.**
7. We are required to have a minimum number of people (30-35) on the bus. If our minimum is not reached, other options will be explored, including a possible cancellation of the trip.
8. For your safety, we ask that you remain seated until the bus comes to a complete stop.
9. Payment by check, cash, money order, MasterCard, Discover or Visa is accepted. Make checks payable to: **Town of Parma.**

### **Cancellations & Refund Policy:**

1. Cancellations received in the Recreation Department (392-9030) prior to the trip confirmation deadline will be refunded with a processing fee of 10%. Cancellations received after the confirmation date or "no shows" will **NOT** receive a refund unless someone else is found to take the place of the cancelled party. **We will attempt to give refunds whenever possible, but please realize that refunds are NOT guaranteed.** If a refund is approved you also have the option to put a full credit for the amount paid on your account to be used at a later date.

2. All replacements will be handled by the Recreation Department from the waiting list if one exists. You may give your spot to a friend if there is no waiting list established.
