Tillman's Village Inn Luncheon Show Albion, NY

Take this musical journey with the classics of the golden age with classics of Frank Sinatra, Bing Crosby, Nat King Cole and a host of others at the famous **Tillman's Village Inn**. This luncheon Show "**Back in the Day**", featuring **Kirk McWhorter**, an award winning vocalist who sings tunes from the 30's, 40's and 50's. Tillman's originated in 1824 and has been famous for its prime rib. The day doesn't end with the show, but continues with a shopping opportunity available on the way home to **Liberty Hollow** located right here in Parma, for antiques, collectibles & gifts with Dunkin Donuts next door (on own-\$).

WALKING: Level 1 (1-3 Scale, 3 being a lot of walking)

MEAL: Bruschetta Chicken-boneless chicken breast grilled, topped with fresh roma tomatoes, garlic, basil and olive oil with baked potato OR 8 oz. Prime Rib served with baked potato. Dessert is an ice cream parfait with coffee/tea included.
DEADLINE: **Thursday, March 1st; minimum 20**

Eldred WWII Museum & Sprague's Maple Farms Eldred, PA & Portville, NY

The **Eldred WWII Museum** features three levels of World War II memorabilia, including huge model displays that you can drive toy tanks over, replicas of life-size submarines, life-size bunkers you can walk inside and thousands of artifacts from guns to patches and flags to uniforms. Then it's off to a delicious lunch at **Sprague's Maple Farms** for some down home cooking (possible maple tour-not definite). **Cuba Cheese Shoppe** here we come – in business for 42 years now, with over 400 types of cheeses; also offering local maple syrup, salt rising bread and more. A stop at Tom Wahl's (on own-\$) on the way home.

Sherwood Inn Lunch & "Mamma Mia" at Merry-Go-Round Skaneateles & Auburn, NY

We will make our first stop at what used to be an 1807 stage coach stop for a delicious lunch at the cozy **Sherwood Inn** in Skaneateles. Then it's onto the Merry-Go-Round Theater in Auburn, NY to see "**Mamma Mia**" - A mother, a daughter – three possible dads, musical comedy – set in the backdrop of the Greek Islands. Based on the songs of ABBA, songs will include: "Dancing Queen", "Gimme, Gimme, Gimme" and of course the title hit, "Mamma Mia"! You will want to get up and dance, BUT you can't. After the show, it's onto a favorite stop; **Sauders Country Store** in Seneca Falls owned and operated by the Amish.

Presque Isle & Erie
Erie, PA

We start our journey in Erie and meet our guide at **Pulako's Chocolates** for a tour of the chocolate factory that blends the old "I Love Lucy", with the new, with samples. It is then off for a narrated tour at **Presque Isle State Park** which includes a cookout lunch. Don't forget dessert... how does build your own sundae at **Sally's** sound? You will get a cup of yummy vanilla ice cream and continue down the buffet topping line to add your own hot fudge, peanut butter, strawberries, nuts, etc. It's then back into **Erie** for a city tour showcasing **Millionaires Row, Watson Curtze Mansion, Downtown Area, & Bay Front area** including the **Don Jon Shipbuilding**, the only dry dock on the Great Lakes. MEAL: You'll enjoy non-alcoholic white peach-grape cocktail, Luigi's signature yorkshire salad, homemade pumpkin bread, Roasted Pork Loin Medallions bathed in a tantalizing albicocca sauce, milano cheddar rice pilaf, steamed broccoli in a parmesan sauce, our signature butterscotch bliss dessert, coffee and a variety of gourmet tea selections!

Registration Procedure and Information:

1. Pick-up and departure from Hilton Senior Center, 59 Henry Street, Hilton, NY.
2. **Since the Town of Parma subsidizes these trips, they are open to Town of Parma** residents age 55 and up at a subsidized rate. Those who do not live in the Town of Parma will be accommodated if space is available; however they will be required to register at a non-resident rate.
 - a. **If you pay Hilton School Taxes but do not pay Town of Parma taxes, the non-resident rate will apply.**
3. The following is the procedure for trip registration: Complete registration form or register online at www.parmany.org/Recreation at any time after a trip is advertised. Completed forms should be turned into the Recreation Office. For any seating requests, submit information on the registration form with any other requirements such as food choice and emergency contact. Places cannot be held for people without payment and we will take a waiting list if a bus fills. If cancellations occur, placements will be taken in order from the waiting list.

4. We recommend that interested participants register for any trip by the stated registration deadline or 3-4 weeks prior to the trip date at the latest.
5. **REMINDER:** The first two sets of seats are reserved for those who have a difficult time maneuvering up and down the aisle and will be rotated to share this opportunity to all. **NOTE:** Front seat requests will be taken at registration but please be aware that these seats are limited.
6. Please be at the pick-up point at least 10 minutes prior to the designated departure time. **Passengers should NOT plan to board the bus early to save seats.**
7. We are required to have a minimum number of people attend each trip. If our minimum is not reached, other options will be explored, including a possible cancellation of the trip.
8. For your safety, we ask that you remain seated until the bus comes to a complete stop.
9. Payment by check, cash, money order, MasterCard, Discover or Visa is accepted. Make checks payable to: **Town of Parma**.
10. Other day trips not included on this document may be added throughout the year.

Cancellations & Refund Policy:

1. Cancellations received in the Recreation Department (392-9030) prior to the trip registration deadline may be refunded with a processing fee of 10%. Cancellations received after the deadline or "no shows" will **NOT** receive a refund unless someone else is found to take the place of the cancelled party. **We will attempt to give refunds whenever possible, but please realize that refunds are NOT guaranteed.** If a refund is approved you also have the option to put a full credit for the amount paid on your account to be used at a later date.
2. All replacements will be handled by the Recreation Department from the waiting list if one exists. You may give your spot to a friend if there is no waiting list established.
