

HILTON-PARMA RECREATION 2013 Ski Club Rules

General Rules:

- Ski Club is for Hilton School District Students ONLY that is pre-registered.
- Ski Club consists of Middle School & High School Students-grades 7 thru 12.
- School attendance the trip day and the following day is expected. Illegal absences may result in disciplinary action.
- Ski Club will not be held if schools are closed due to weather. Or if the weather is questionable, an announcement will be made at school.
- If you are suspended from school, you will not be able to participate in Ski Club while you are out of school.
- Students must follow the rules of the advisors/chaperones at all times.
- Lift and rental coupons will be handed out each week by the chaperone on your bus. If you miss a trip, your ticket will be available the following day at Hilton-Parma Recreation.
- Hilton-Parma Recreation is not responsible for stolen items while at Bristol or on the bus. Label everything when possible.
- Use or possession of alcohol or use of illegal drugs is forbidden and will result in forfeiture of your ski season.
- Appropriate language should be used at all times.

Bus Rules:

- Anyone who joins Ski Club must ride the bus to/from Bristol, unless you have a written note to the advisor.
- If any damage occurs to the bus, you will be removed from Ski Club and billed for the damages. Hilton-Parma Recreation will not be responsible for the repair.
- Absolutely NO smoking on the bus.
- Eating and drinking will be allowed on the bus, however if chaperones feel this privilege is getting out of hand at any time, it will be taken away. Cans or bottled soft drinks/water are allowed.
- Buses must be clean at the end of each trip-each student needs to take care of their own mess.
- MP3 players and ipods are allowed, however radios are not allowed. Keep them locked!
- Rated PG or PG-13 movies are allowed on the bus for the entire bus to watch.

Mountain Rules:

- Ski Club participants should not leave the ski area grounds at any time.
- You are required to take a lesson if you have less than 2 years' experience.
- Ski/ride slopes appropriate to your ability.
- If you are expelled from Ski Club while at the Ski area, you will not be able to ride the bus back to the school. Your parents will be notified to come and get you. Tickets and rental coupons will be returned to you.
- Ski/Ride with a buddy.
- Stop skiing/riding when you are tired, cold or hungry.
- Do not cut lift lines.
- No reckless skiing/riding.
- No horseplay or obnoxious behavior.
- Bring quarters for the lockers.
- It is highly recommended that all students lock their equipment while at Bristol.
- In the event of an accident or injury at the mountain, parents will be called. Depending upon the seriousness, parents may be requested to drive to Bristol to pick up their child.
- You must be on time for the bus!! Buses will depart Bristol at approximately 9:15 p.m.

2013 Ski Club Schedule

Five trips to Bristol: Wednesday nights of 1/9, 1/16, 1/30; 2/6 and all day Monday, 1/21(Martin Luther King Day). Make-up date is 2/13 or 2/27. On Wednesdays, Middle School students will be transported over to the High School and buses will depart the High School at 2:45 p.m. and returning at 10:30 p.m.

SKI CLUB Helpful Hints

What to pack:

Pack warm clothes and pack extra clothes! Bring long johns, snow pants, jacket, mittens, hat, neck warmer, goggles, etc.

Students are strongly encouraged to wear a helmet at all times, whether they are skiing or snowboarding. These can be purchased through Bristol at a discount.

****Bring an extra pair of socks to change in at Bristol. This will insure that the socks that you put on are DRY and will help keep your feet warm. The best bet is a pair of socks specifically made for skiing/riding.**

What to do for dinner:

There are various options-

Pack dinner/snacks

Pack part of your dinner (sandwich) and buy the rest (drink, french fries)

Buy your entire dinner at Bristol. They serve hamburgers, pizza, soup, salad, etc. Dinner can cost between \$5-\$10.

General Ski Club Itinerary:

We provide a safe location in each school to store your skis/snowboard/bags. The Middle School stores gear in a closet on the 2nd floor-this will be explained at a Ski Club meeting once registration is closed. The High School stores gear at the concession stand outside of the athletic office/gym. Both gear site spots are unlocked at the end of the day.

- 2:15 Middle School students-go to your locker to gather anything that you will need for the evening.
- 2:20 Middle School students-get your ski/snowboard gear and begin to look for the bus in the loop.
- 2:20 High School students-go to your locker and pick up anything that you will need for the evening.
- 2:25 Middle School motor coach departs for the High School to pick up remaining students.
- 2:30 High School students-go to the concession stand near athletic office to get your ski/snowboard gear.
- 2:35 High School students-remain in the foyer at the concession stand for the motor coach buses to arrive.
- 2:45 Motor coaches depart the High School for Bristol.
- 3:45 Arrival at Bristol-go to the rental shop if needed.
- 4:00 Lessons are available, 5:00 lessons are for beginners. Ski time till 8:45 p.m.
- 5:00 thru 8:00 Check-in with advisors or chaperones in the lodge; eat dinner.
- 8:45 Begin to head in and return rental equipment if needed. Buses depart at 9:15 p.m.
- 9:15 Buses depart Bristol-DO NOT BE LATE!!
- 10:30 Buses arrive at High School-please have your ride arranged and possibly use your cell to update who might be picking you up from the High School.

Students: In case of an emergency at Bristol:

Our main advisor will have a pager at the mountain. If you need assistance, ask a Bristol employee to page a Hilton Advisor/Chaperone.
