JUNIOR Playground

SENIOR Playground

Entering grades 6, 7, 8, 9 in Fall
MAX ENROLLMENT—120 campers per week
Home base-Merton Williams MIR

B&AR Program(...we call it BEAR)

B&AR stands for before and after resource which is a wrap-around program with extended hours for those that need it; for youth enrolled in JR/INT/SR Playground only.

TIME: 7:00 a.m.-8:30 a.m. and/or 3:30 p.m.-5:30 p.m.
COST: \$40 per week resident/district fee
\$50 per week non-resident/non-district
\$200 resident/district all six weeks at once
\$250 non-resident/non-district all six weeks

Field Trips—NEW FORMAT THIS YEAR

One field trip per week is scheduled and is offered for each age group and is built into the cost of camp. By signing up for camp you are signing your child up for the offered field trips. If you wish for your child to stay back at camp, he/she may stay with one of the other groups but you will not receive a pro-rated refund for missing a trip. There is no option to stay back at the playground home-base site for the trips to Parma Town Park; all kids attend or stay home. A detailed Field Trip Schedule will be available upon registration, but please be aware that field trips are subject to change.

Swimming

Swimming will be available for each age group once per week. It is included in the cost of camp. All kids will be tested by a Water Safety Instructor on their first trip to the pool.

Friday Lunch—NEW THIS YEAR!

Children are required to bring lunch daily but lunch will be available every Friday by the Hilton Methodist Church in addition to a snack every Wednesday!

Ice Cream

Abbott's, Lugia's and Kona Ice will visit for ice cream and shaved ice on Thursdays. This will be an additional \$3-5.
