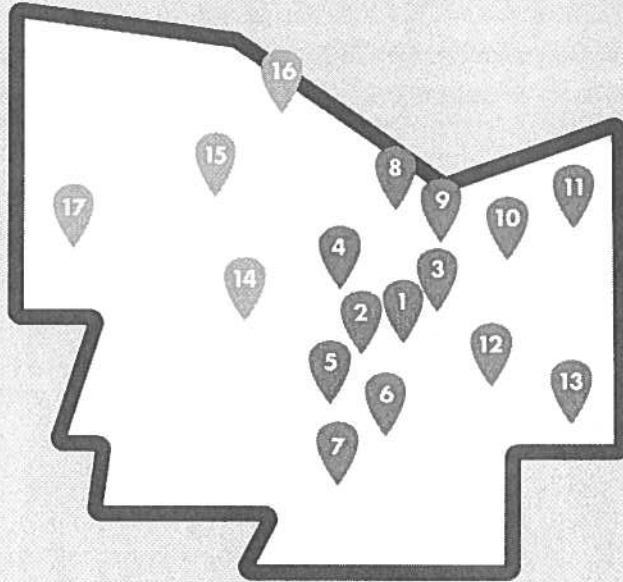


General Election 2024 Early Voting Sites
